#317 – Service of Alcohol

Rationale:

The presence of alcoholic beverages on Lynn Valley United Church premises raises competing values. A policy that is based on consideration of differing perspectives is required to assist staff in their handling of this sensitive issue. These values include:

- LVUC values inclusivity: the church should be a welcoming environment for all, even those who may be uncomfortable in the presence of alcohol at church.
- A sense of community is promoted by social events; these often include the service of alcohol.
- Wine in particular has a spiritual significance in Christianity.
- Alcohol can impair one's judgment and physical capacities. This may expose the church to liability.

Policy:

- 1. LVUC may use wine for sacramental purposes at the discretion of the Lead Minister.
- 2. LVUC will not use alcohol beverage sales as a primary revenue source at an event.
- 3. LVUC will comply with all requirements of the Liquor Distribution Branch (LDB) regarding permits and server certifications
- 4. There will be no use of church resources for the purchase of alcoholic beverages except with specific approval of the Lead Minister.
- 5. Alcohol will not be served to minors on church premises.
- 6. Alcohol on the church premises will be kept securely.
